Admission into B.Sc. (Hons.) Agriculture, B.Tech. (Agricultural Engineering), B.Tech. (Food Technology) and B.Sc. (Hons.) Community Science courses under NRI/NRI Sponsored Quota for the AY 2026-27

An applicant seeking admission under NRI/NRI sponsored quota shall submit Online application within the prescribed date. Non-Resident Indians staying abroad for a minimum period of one year (as on the last date for submission of Online application), can only sponsor a candidate for admission under the quota.

- An Indian Citizen who stays abroad for employment/carrying on business or vocation outside India or stays abroad under circumstances indicating an intention for an uncertain duration of stay abroad is a non-resident, (Indian Persons posted in U.N. Organisations and Officials deputed abroad by Central/State Governments and Public Sector undertakings on temporary assignments are also treated as non-residents). Non-Resident international citizens of Indian Origin are treated on par with non-resident Indian citizens (NRI).
- An individual will be treated as a Non-Resident in India in any previous year if he/she has not resided in India for:
 - At least 182 days in the year of admission, **OR**
 - At least 365 days during 4 years preceding the year of admission **AND** at least 60 days in the year of admission.
- An individual who does not satisfy above mentioned conditions will be treated as **Resident Indian**.
- **Indian citizens having NRI status shall sponsor their own siblings / any blood relatives** supported by passport / other relevant documents as proof for their support of nominations.
- If any seats are leftover under NRI category, the same may be filled up with Indian Nationals having essential qualifications.

Bi.P.C stream

Eligibility:

The applicant must have passed 12th standard (English Medium) from an Indian Board or an equivalent Board outside the country with the subjects of Biological and Physical Sciences for admission into B.Sc. (Hons.) Agriculture, B.Tech. (Food Technology) and B.Sc. (Hons.) Community Science (Bi.P.C. stream) under NRI/NRI Sponsored quota.

Criteria for selection:

The selection of candidates shall be based on the merit list prepared on the basis of the marks secured in Intermediate (10+2) or its equivalent. In case of a tie, the marks in the optional subjects viz., Biology/ (Botany, Zoology) followed by Physics and Chemistry shall be taken into consideration and in case of further tie, the age of the candidate shall be taken into consideration and the older candidates shall be given preference.

M.P.C stream

Eligibility:

The applicant must have passed 12th standard (English Medium) from an Indian Board or an equivalent Board outside the country with the subjects of Mathematics and Physical Sciences for admission into B.Tech. (Agricultural Engineering), B.Tech. (Food Technology) and B.Sc. (Hons.) Community Science (M.P.C stream) under NRI/NRI Sponsored quota.

Criteria for selection:

The selection of candidates shall be based on the merit list prepared on the basis of the marks secured in Intermediate (10+2) or its equivalent. In case of a tie, the marks in the optional subjects viz., Mathematics followed by Physics and Chemistry shall be taken into consideration and in case of further tie, the age of the candidate shall be taken into consideration and the older candidates shall be given preference.

General Instructions for Bi.P.C. & M.P.C Stream courses:

A good knowledge of English is compulsory. A certificate of the candidate's proficiency in English issued by the respective Indian Mission abroad or recognized agencies should accompany their applications for admission.

The students seeking admission under the quota are not required to appear for any Entrance test(s) of the state or the country.

Age limit for Bi.P.C. & M.P.C Stream courses:

The applicant should have completed 17 years of age as on 31st December of the year of admission with an upper age limit of 22 years.

Hostel facility:

Hostel facility shall be provided subject to the availability of accommodation in the respective colleges.

Fee structure for the admitted batch of AY 2026-27:

- A. Rs. 10,80,000/- as Institutional Economic Fee for the entire course (@ Rs.1,35,000/- per semester)
 - All other Regular fees (UF & NUF), Hostel & Mess charges and others if any are additional.
- B. If the left over seats under NRI/NRI sponsored quota are filled up with Indian Nationals, the Institutional Economic fee shall be paid @ of Rs.1,35,000/- per semester for eight semesters (Regular fees (UF+NUF), Hostel & Mess charges and others if any are additional).

Documents to be submitted:

1. An undertaking by the candidate and parent on stamp paper (Rs. 100/- or equivalent currency) duly notarized (**ANNEXURE-A**).
2. An undertaking by the Sponsor on stamp paper (Rs. 100/- or equivalent currency) duly notarized (**ANNEXURE-B**).
3. Birth Certificate/Proof of Date of birth
4. Higher Secondary (10+2) or Equivalent Examination Mark Sheet
5. Transfer Certificate/Migration Certificate issued by the Head of the Institute/University last attended (whichever is applicable)
6. Bonafide/Conduct Certificate issued by the Head of Institution last attended
7. Medical fitness Certificate
8. Self certification documents of sponsorer showing the proof of NRI status.
9. Work Permit or Business Establishment, as applicable
10. Valid Passport and Visa of the Financial Sponsor.
11. The Bank statement showing the latest transaction of the previous 6 months.

Note:

- **Candidates are required to read the PROSPECTUS thoroughly before applying.**
- The selected candidates under NRI/NRI Sponsored shall be treated on par with regular students. No special amenities or facilities shall be provided.
- The University shall not own the responsibility of the applicant's involvement in any unlawful activities during the period of study and he/she is solely responsible and shall be required to appear for any enquiry from the police or any other competent authority.
- The candidates admitted under this quota are not eligible for any reimbursement of fee or any other educational concessions offered by the Government.
- Furnishing of any false information in the application shall result in cancellation of admission at any stage.
- **All the rules and regulations governing UG programmes shall apply to the candidates selected under NRI/NRI Sponsored quota also.**
- **If the admitted candidate cancels his/her seat before the closure of admissions for the AY 2026-27, an amount of Rs. 10,000/- shall be collected as processing fee. The remaining fee already paid during admission shall be refunded.**
- **Any cancellation/withdrawal of admissions after the closure of admission process for the AY 2026-27, the candidate shall forfeit the entire fee (Except the caution deposits), in addition, the candidate has to pay Rs. 10,000/- as processing fee.**
- Candidates shall have to attend for certificate verification at their own cost.
- The applicant is informed that mere submission of an online application and attending for certificate verification does not automatically guarantee the seat.
- **The University does not guarantee any employment to the candidates.**
- Professor Jayashankar Telangana Agricultural University (PJTU) is the only Agricultural University in the State. The University has not accorded any affiliation to any private colleges in Telangana State.
- The University is not responsible for the information provided in other websites.
- Parents and Students are informed that the admissions are purely based on merit and guidelines of the University and as such they are requested not to rely on any

middlemen/persons/consultants who try to mislead the students in securing admission into PJTAU under any quota. All the seats shall be filled by the University only.
